

ABOUT THE VILLAGE – MIYANI

Mayani is a medium size village located in Pokhari Tehsil of Chamoli district, Uttarakhand with total 55 families residing. The Mayani village has population of 254 of which 138 are males while 116 are females as per Population Census 2011.

In Mayani village population of children with age 0-6 is 43 which makes up 16.93 % of total population of village. Average Sex Ratio of Mayani village is 841 which is lower than Uttarakhand state average of 963. Child Sex Ratio for the Mayani as per census is 654, lower than Uttarakhand average of 890.

Mayani village has higher literacy rate compared to Uttarakhand. In 2011, literacy rate of Mayani village was 88.63 % compared to 78.82 % of Uttarakhand. In Mayani Male literacy stands at 97.32 % while female literacy rate was 78.79 %.
